

VERBS in SPANISH

In Spanish subject pronouns such as I, you, he are relatively unimportant. It is the ending of the verb that indicates the doer of the action. In Spanish the verb ending changes in order to indicate the tense of the verb.

PRESENT TENSE (REGULAR) To form the present tense of ar verbs (first conjugation verbs) the infinitive ending **ar** is dropped. To the root are added the personal endings.

I	eat
You	eat
<u>He/She/it</u>	<u>eats</u>
We	eat
You	eat
They	eat

Para hacer preguntas es necesario utilizar el verbo auxiliar: to do. Observe que este verbo auxiliar se coloca primero y es el único que cambia en la tercera persona del singular (he, she, it).
